In today's world, however, it is dangerous to seem power hungry, to move overt with your power. We have to be honest and decent. So we have to be subtle — sympathetic but cunning, democratic and yet cunning. Learning the game of power requires a certain way of looking at the world, a shift of perspective. Certain basic skills are required, and once you have mastered these skills, you can apply the laws of power more easily. **LAW 1: NEVER SURPASS THE MASTER** Always make those above you feel comfortably superior. In your desire to please and impress them, don't go too far in showing your talents or your might achieve the opposite-inspiring fear and uncertainty. Make your masters look more brilliant than they are, and you will reach the heights of power. **WET 2: NEVER RELY TOO MUCH ON FRIENDS, LEARN HOW TO USE ENEMIES** Be wary of friends — they'll betray you faster, because they're easily excited to be jealous. They are also spoiled and tyrannical. But hire a former enemy and he'll be more loyal than a friend, because he has more to prove. In fact, you have more to fear from friends than from enemies. If you don't have enemies, find a way to make them. **WET 3: DISGUISE YOUR INTENTIONS** Keep people off balance and in the dark by never revealing the purpose behind your actions. If they have no idea what you are from now, they can't prepare a defense. Lead them far enough down the wrong path, enveloping them in enough smoke, and by the time they realize your intentions, it will be too late. **Part I:** Use conducted objects of desire and red pegs to throw people out of the scent **Part II:** Use smoke screens to disguise your actions **law 4: ALWAYS SAY LESS THAN NECESSARY** When you try to impress people with words, the more you say, the more you appear, and the less in control. Even if you say something banal, it will look original if you make it vague, open and sphinxlike. Powerful people impress and intimidate by saying less. The more you say, the more likely you are to say something stupid. **LAW 5: SO MUCH DEPENDS ON REPUTATION- GUARDING WITH YOUR LIFE** Reputation is the cornerstone of power. By reputation alone you can intimidate and win; once it slips, however, you are vulnerable, and will be on all sides Make your reputation untouchable. Always be alert to possible attacks and thwart them before they happen. Meanwhile, learn to destroy your enemies by opening holes in their own reputation. Then stand aside and public opinion hangs them. **LAW 6: COURT ATTENTION AT ALL COSTS** Everything is judged on his appearance; What's unseen counts for nothing. Never let yourself get lost in the crowd, then, or buried in oblivion. Stand out, at all costs. Make yourself a magnet of attention by appearing bigger, more colorful, more mysterious than the boring and timid masses. **Part I:** Surround your name with the sensational and outrageous. Draw attention to yourself. **Part II:** Create an atmosphere of mystery. Don't leave all your cards **Law 7: LET OTHERS DO THE WORK FOR YOU, BUT ALWAYS TAKE THE CREDIT** Use the wisdom, knowledge and legwork of other people to further your own business. Not only does such a help save you precious time and energy, it will give you a divine aura of efficiency and speed. Eventually, your helpers will be forgotten and you will be remembered. Never do what others can do for you. **Law 8:** Let other people come to you — **USE AAS IF NECESSARY** When you force the other to act, you are the one in control. It's always better to let your opponent come to you, drop his own plans in the process. Lure him with fantastic gains-then attack. You hold the cards. **LAW 9: WIN THROUGH YOUR ACTIONS, NEVER THROUGH ARGUMENT** Every momentary triumph you think you have gained through argument is truly a Pyrrhic victory: The resentment and ill will stir you is stronger and lasts longer than a momentary change of mind. It is much more powerful to get others to agree with you through your actions, without saying a word. Demonstrate, not explain. **Law 10: INFECTION: AVOID THE UNFORTUNATE AND UNFORTUNATE** You die of the misery of someone else's emotional states are as contagious as diseases. You feel like you're helping the drowning man, but you're just rushing your own disaster. The unfortunate sometimes draw unhappiness on themselves; They'll draw it on you, too. Associate with the happy and happy instead. **WET 11: LEARN TO KEEP PEOPLE** dependent on you To maintain your independence, you must always be needed and wanted. The more you are trusted, the more freedom you have. Make people dependent on you for their happiness and prosperity and you have nothing to fear. Never teach them enough so they can live without you. **LAW 12: USE SELECTIVE HONESTY AND GENEROSITY TO DISARM YOUR VICTIM** A sincere and honest move will involve dozens of dishonest. Openhearted gestures of honesty and generosity bring the guard of even the most suspicious people. Once your selective honesty opens a hole in their armor, you cheat and manipulate them to will. A timely gift - a Trojan horse - will serve the same purpose. **Law 13:** When asking for help, appeal to people's self-interest, never to their mercy or gratitude if you have to turn to an ally for help, don't bother to remind him of your past help and good deeds. He'll find a way to ignore you. Instead, discover something in your request, or in your alliance with him, that that benefit him, and emphasize it out of all proportion. He'll react enthusiastically when he sees that there's something to be gained for himself. **LAW 14: IMAGINE YOURSELF AS A FRIEND, WORK AS A SPY** Knowing about your rival is crucial. Use spies to gather valuable information that will keep you one step ahead. Better yet: Play the spy yourself. In polite social encounters, learn to probe. Ask indirect questions to help people reveal their weaknesses and intentions. There is no opportunity that is not an opportunity for artful espionage. **LAW 15: CRUSH YOUR ENEMY TOTALLY** All the great leaders since Moses have known that a feared enemy must be completely crushed. (Sometimes they learned this the hard way.) If a cinder is set on fire, no matter how weak it smolders, a fire will eventually break out. More is lost by stopping halfway than by total destruction: The enemy will recover, and seek revenge. Crush him, not just in the body, but in the mind. **LAW 16: USE ABSENCE TO INCREASE RESPECT AND HONOR** Too much circulation makes the price down: The more you are seen and heard, the more you appear. If you are already established in a group, temporary withdrawal from it will make you more talked about, even more admired. You have to learn when to leave. Create value through scarcity. **WET 17: KEEP OTHERS IN SUSPENDED TERROR:** Cultivate An AIR OF UNPREDICTABILITY Humans are creatures of habit with an insatiable need to see familiarity in other people's actions. Your predictability gives them a sense of control. Turn the tables: Be deliberately unpredictable. Behavior that doesn't seem to have consistency or purpose will keep them out of balance, and they'll wear themselves out to explain your movements. Taken to the extreme, this strategy can intimidate and terrorize. **LAW 18: DON'T BUILD FORTRESSES TO PROTECT YOURSELF- ISOLATION IS DANGEROUS** The world is dangerous and enemies are everywhere — everyone has to protect themselves. A fortress seems to be the safest. But isolation exposes you to more dangers than it protects you from - it cuts you off from valuable information, it makes you conspicuous and an easy target. Better to circulate among the people, find allies, and mingle. You're shielded from your enemies by the mob. **LAW 19: KNOW WHO YOU'RE DEALING WITH — DON'T INSULT THE WRONG PERSON** There are many different kinds of people in the world, and you never assume that everyone will react to your strategies in the same way. Cheat or drown out some people and they will spend the rest of their lives looking for revenge. They're wolves in lamb's clothes. Choose your victims and opponents carefully, then - never offend or cheat the wrong person. **LAW 20: DON'T COMMIT TO ANYONE** It's the fool who's always in a hurry to take sides. Not connecting to one side or cause, but yourself. By You to preserve, you become the master of others - people play against each other, causing them to chase you. **Part I:** Don't commit to anyone, but let everyone court you. **Part II:** Not Not for everyone - stay above the fray. **Law 21:** PLAY a sucker to catch a suction cup-seem dumber than your brand No one likes feeling dumber than the next person. The trick is to make your victims feel smart and not only smart, but also smarter than you. Once convinced of this, they will never suspect that you have ulterior motives. **LAW 22: USE THE SURRENDER TACTIC: TURN WEAKNESS INTO POWER** If you are weaker, never fight for honor; opt for surrender instead. Surrender gives you time to recover, time to torment and irritate your conqueror, time to wait for his power to wane. Don't give him the satisfaction of fighting and defeating you — surrender first. By turning the other cheek you will infuriate and upset him. Make surrender a means of power. **WET 23: CONCENTRATE YOUR FORCES** To maintain your powers and energies by keeping them focused on their strongest point. You get more by finding a rich mine and mining it deeper, than by flitting from one shallow mine to another-intensity beats extensively every time. When looking for sources of power to elevate you, find the one important pattern, the fat cow that gives you milk for a long time to come. **LAW 24: PLAY THE PERFECT COURTIER** The perfect courtier thrives in a world where it's all about power and political agility. He masters the art of circumstantial; he flatters, gives to superiors, and asserts power over others in the most oblique and graceful way. Learn and adjust the laws of courtier and there will be no limit to how far you rise in court. **WET 25: RE-CREATE YOURSELF** Don't Accept the roles society knew about you. Re-create yourself by forging a new identity, one that commands attention and never bores the audience. Be the master of your own image instead of letting others define it for you. Include dramatic devices in your public gestures and actions - your power is enhanced and your character seems larger than life. **WET 26: KEEP YOUR HANDS CLEAN** You must seem like a paragon of civility and efficiency: Your hands are never soiled by mistakes and nasty deeds. Maintain such a flawless appearance by using others as scapegoats and cat paws to disguise your involvement. **Part I:** Hide your mistakes — have a scapegoat to take the blame. **Part II:** Use the 'Cat's Paw' — someone who does the dirty work for you. **LAW 27: PLAY ON PEOPLE'S NEED TO BELIEVE TO CREATE A CULTLIKE FOLLOWING PEOPLE HAVE AN OVERWHELMING DESIRE TO BELIEVE IN SOMETHING.** Become the focal point of such desire by offering them a purpose, a new faith that follows. Keep your words vague, but full of promise; enthusiasm about rationality and clear thinking. Give your new disciples rituals to perform, ask them to make sacrifices on your behalf. In the absence of organised religion and causes, your new belief system will bring you untold power. **WET 28: TAKE ACTION WITH DARING** If you're not sure of a course of action, don't try it. Your doubts and and will infect your execution. Timidity is dangerous: Better to come in with courage. Any mistakes you commit through daring are easily corrected with more audacity. Everyone admires the boldness; No one honors the timid. **LAW 29: PLAN ALL THE WAY TO THE END** The end is everything. Plan all the way to it, taking into account all the possible consequences, obstacles and twists of fortune that could reverse your hard work and give the glory to others. By planning to end you will not be overwhelmed by circumstances and you know when to stop. Cautiously guide fortune and help determine the future by thinking far ahead. **WET 30: MAKE YOUR PERFORMANCE SEEM EFFORTLESS** Your actions should seem natural and executed with ease. All the toil and practice that go into them, and also all the clever tricks, must be hidden. If you act, act effortlessly, as if you do much more. Avoid the temptation to reveal how hard you work, it only raises questions. Don't teach anyone your tricks or they will be used against you. **LAW 31: CONTROL THE OPTIONS: LET OTHERS PLAY WITH THE CARDS YOU DEAL** The best disappointments are the ones that seem to give the other person a choice: Your victims feel they are in control, but are actually your puppets. Give people options that come in your favor whichever they choose. Force them to make choices between the lesser of two evils, both of whom serve your purpose. Put them on the horns of a dilemma: they are gored wherever they turn. **LAW 32: PLAY WITH PEOPLE'S FANTASIES** The truth is often avoided because it is ugly and unpleasant. Never appeal to truth and reality unless you are prepared for the anger that comes from disillusionment. Life is so hard and harrowing that people who can produce romance or conjure up fantasy as oases in the desert: Everyone is coming. There is great power in tapping into the fantasies of the masses. **LAW 33: DISCOVER THE THUMB-shaking OF EVERY MAN** Everyone has a weakness, a hole in the castle wall. That weakness is usually an uncertainty, an uncontrollable emotion or need; It can also be a small secret delight. Anyway, once found, it's a thumbscrew you turn in your favor. **Law 34: BE ROYAL IN YOUR OWN WAY: ACT LIKE A KING TO BE TREATED LIKE ONE** The way you carry yourself will often determine how you are treated: In the long run, appear vulgar or common will make people disrespect you. For a king respects himself and inspires the same feeling in others. By acting regally and confidently in your powers, you make yourself seem destined to wear a crown. **LAW 35: MASTER THE ART OF TIMING** Never seem to be in a hurry-hurrying betrays a lack of control over yourself, and over time. Always seem patient, as if you know everything until you come. Become a detective at the right time; sniff the spirit of time, the trends that will bring you to power. Learn to catch up when the time is not yet right, and to strike fiercely when it has reached **Law 36: CONTEMPT THINGS YOU DON'T HAVE:** Ignoring them is the best revenge By acknowledging a petty problem you give the existence and credibility. The more attention you pay to an enemy, the stronger you make him; and a small error is often made worse and more visible when you try to confirm it. Sometimes it's best to leave things alone. If there's anything you want but can't have, show contempt for it. The less interest you reveal, the more superior you seem. **LAW 37: MAKE ENVIVING GLASSES** Striking images and grand symbolic gestures create the aura of power — everyone reacts to it. Stage goggles for those around you, then full of arresting visuals and radiant symbols that enhance your presence. Blinded by appearances, no one will notice what you're really doing. **LAW 38: THINK WHAT YOU WANT, BUT BEHAVE LIKE OTHERS** If you have a show of going against time, showing off your unconventional ideas and unorthodox ways, people will think that you only want attention and that you look down on them. They'll find a way to punish you for feeling inferior. It is much safer to blend in and feed the common touch. Share your originality only with tolerant friends and those who certainly appreciate your uniqueness. **LAW 39: STIR WATERS TO CATCH fish** Anger and emotion are strategically counterproductive. You must always remain calm and objective. But if you upset your enemies while staying calm, you get a definit advantage. Unbalance your enemies: Find the crack in their vanity that allows you to rattle them and you hold the strings. **WET 40: DESPISE THE FREE LUNCH** What is offered for free is dangerous-it usually involves either a trick or a hidden obligation. What's worth it is worth paying for. By paying your own way, you stay away from gratitude, guilt and deceit. It is also often wise to pay the full price - there is no cutting angles with excellence. Be generous with your money and keep it circulating, because generosity is a sign and a magnet for power. **LAW 41: AVOID STEPPING INTO THE SHOES OF A GREAT MAN** What happens first always seems better and more original than what comes next. If you succeed a great man or have a famous parent, you will have to double achieve their achievements to surpass them. Don't get lost in their shadow, or get stuck in a past not of your own making: Establish your own name and identity by changing course. Kill the overbearing father, resent his legacy and gain power by shining in your own way. **WET 42: Strike THE SHEPHERD AND THE SHEEP WILL SCATTER** Trouble can often be traced back to a single strong individual - the helmer, the arrogant underling, the poisoner of goodwill. If you allow such people space to work, others will succumb to their Don't wait for the problems they cause to multiply, don't try to negotiate with them — they are irreparable. Neutralize their influence by isolating or eliminating them. Hit the source of the problems and the sheep will scatter. **Distro. 43: WORK ON THE HEARTS AND MINDS OF OTHERS** Coercion creates a reaction that will eventually work against you. You have to entice others to want to go in your direction. A person who has been seduced becomes your trusty pawn. And the way to entice others is to work on their individual psychologies and weaknesses. Soothe the resistance by working on their emotions, playing on what they hold dear and what they fear. Ignore the hearts and minds of others and they will grow to hate you. **LAW 44: DisARM AND INFURIATE WITH THE MIRROR EFFECT** The mirror reflects reality, but it's also the perfect tool for deception: If you mirror your enemies, do exactly what they do, they can't figure out your strategy. The Mirror Effect mocks and humiliates them, causing them to overreact. By holding up a mirror to their psyches, you seduce them with the illusion that you share their values. By holding up a mirror to their actions, you teach them a lesson. Few can resist the power of the Mirror Effect. **LAW 45: PREdik the need for change, but NEVER TOO MUCH REFORM AT ONCE** Everyone understands the need for change in the abstract, but on the daily level people are creatures of habit. Too much innovation is traumatic and will lead to rebellion. If you're new to a position of power, or an outsider trying to build a power base, make a show of respect for the old way of doing things. If change is needed, make it feel like a gentle improvement of the past. **LAW 46: NEVER APPEAR TOO PERFECTLY** better than others is always dangerous, but the most dangerous of all is to seem to have no mistakes or weaknesses. Envy creates silent enemies. It is smart to occasionally display flaws, and admit to harmless vices, to deflect envy and seem more human and approachable. Only gods and dead can seem perfect with impunity. **LAW 47: DO NOT GO BEYOND THE MARK YOU INTENDED; IN VICTORY, LEARNING WHEN TO STOP** The moment of victory is often the moment of greatest danger. In the heat of victory, arrogance and hubris can push you past the goal you had pursued, and by going too far, you can make more enemies than you defeat. Don't let success go to your head. There is no substitute for strategy and careful planning. Set a goal, and when you reach it, stop. **LAW 48: TAKE SHAPELESSNESS** By taking shape, by having a visible plan, you open yourself to attack. Instead of taking a form for your enemy to understand, keep yourself adaptable and moving. Accept the fact that nothing is certain and that no law has been enacted. The best way to protect yourself is to be as liquid and shapeless as water; never bet on stability or lasting order.
